Awards Announced for Bedford County's What's So Cool About Manufacturing® Video Contest

April 27, 2023, BEDFORD, PA – Awards were announced today for the What's So Cool About Manufacturing® video contest that paired teams of students from the Bedford County 21st Century Community Learning Centers' After 3 program at six Bedford County schools with local manufacturers. Students explored manufacturing careers and produced a video profile of their partner manufacturer.

Contest sponsors <u>Bedford County Development Association</u>, <u>Bedford County Technical Center (BCTC)</u>, and the <u>Bedford County 21st Century Community Learning Center Consortium</u> hosted the student teams, manufacturing company representatives, teachers, parents, and local elected officials for an awards luncheon at the Bedford Elks to celebrate the achievements of each team and recognize winners in four categories:

- Best Outreach Plan Award: Tussey Mountain Middle School's After 3 team, which was paired with The Organic Snack Company
- Viewers Choice Award: the After 3 team from Everett Area Middle School for the team's video featuring Lampire Biological Laboratories
- Best Overall Video Award: Bedford Middle School After 3 team featuring Rockland Manufacturing
- Most Educational Award: the After 3 team from Northern Bedford County Middle School featuring Bedford Candies.

Everett Area and Bedford Area teams will advance to represent Bedford County at the state competition at the Whitaker Center for Science & the Arts in Harrisburg on May 15. The Bedford County Viewers Choice contest received a total of 204,332 votes, with more than one-quarter of the votes cast on the third day of the contest.
